RE: Public Notice for Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR), Monitoring, Routine, (DBP), Major/Chlorine

The FAYETTE COUNTY WCID – MONUMENT HILL water system PWS ID 0750009 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period of $\frac{4^{th}}{2000}$ Quarter 2017.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

<u>FAYETTE COUNTY WCID – MONUMENT HILL water system monitors the chlorine residuals at</u> <u>the frequency required by the TCEQ. We produced and submitted the 4th Quarter 2017 report to</u> <u>TCEQ, however, their records do not indicate it was received. The report was resubmitted on April</u> <u>4, 2018. It is important to note that all residuals have been within the range set by TCEQ during</u> <u>the monitoring period.</u>

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
