



Boil Water Notice Rescinded Fayette County WCID Monument Hill December 16, 2025

On December 15, 2025, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the Fayette County WCID Monument Hill, public water system, TX0750009, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of today December 16, 2025.

All affected residents are being asked to run their faucets for 3-5 minutes to bring fresh water into the lines, dump ice from your icemakers, replace your inline refrigerator water filter and flush at least one gallon of water from your refrigerator water dispensers before use.
